Our lodge has 20 fully equipped units with a private bathroom, kitchen and balcony. Each unit has one bedroom with two single beds, apart from our two family units, which have two bedrooms and will accommodate four people.

The Gluyas Rotary Lodge is designed to help you feel at home during treatment. The combination of private and communal areas allows you to mingle with other guests or rest quietly, depending on how you feel.

We have spacious outdoor and indoor recreational areas, with a DVD and book library, BBQ and pool table.

All linen is provided and changed weekly but you are asked to bring your own kitchen and bathroom supplies such as food and toiletries. Dinnerware and basic kitchen utensils are provided. An initial supply of complimentary essentials is provided in each room upon check in (soap, dishwashing liquid etc.), however, you are expected to purchase your own once these run out.

How to get to Gluyas Rotary Lodge

Gluyas Rotary Lodge is about a 10-minute drive from Townsville Airport and Townsville Railway Station. Cancer Council Queensland provides a Monday to Friday travel transfer service between these locations and the lodge. Bookings are essential and are subject to vehicle capacity and volunteer availability. For further information or to make a booking, please contact the lodge on the details below.

Alternatively, cab and ridesharing services are available in Townsville, and there is a local bus stop directly out the front of the lodge. For more information about how to get to the lodge via public transport, please contact our friendly team.
