Our lodge has 14 clean and comfortable rooms, all with their own private bathroom and kitchenette (including a toaster, kettle, bar fridge and microwave). Most rooms are studio-style with two single beds, including one wheelchair accessible room. There are also two larger two-bedroom suites for families.

Our lodge is bright, open and inviting with plenty of communal spaces ideal for both relaxing and socialising. We have a shaded pool and BBQ area for you to use at your leisure. There is also a communal lounge complete with books, DVDs and puzzles which can be borrowed at any time.

Our communal kitchen is equipped with everything needed to make a nutritious meal. There is also a laundry onsite for you to do your own clothes washing. All linen is provided and changed on a weekly basis. An initial supply of complimentary essentials is provided in each room upon check in (tea, coffee, hand soap etc.), however, you are expected to purchase your own once these run out.

How to get to Marylyn Mayo Lodge

Marylyn Mayo Lodge is less than a 20-minute drive from both Cairns Airport and Cairns Central Terminus (for arrivals by bus and train). Arriving by car is easy, as the lodge is located right on the Bruce Highway. Simply ensure you're looking out for signs to Woree and Mulgrave Road.

There is a bus stop within a five-minute walk of the lodge. Cab and ridesharing services are also available in the city.
